



Primary Gold Pty Ltd - Rustlers Roost and Quest 29 Open-cut Mine Redevelopment

Draft Environmental Impact Statement

Hanking Australia Investment Pty Ltd, through its subsidiary Primary Gold Pty Ltd, has submitted a Draft Environmental Impact Statement (Draft EIS).

Primary Gold Pty Ltd proposes to recommence gold mining (three pits) and processing at Rustlers Roost Mine. Five satellite pits at Quest29 Mine will also be mined and ore transported to be processed at Rustlers Roost.

The proposed mine redevelopment is located in the Mount Bundey region, approximately 100km southeast of Darwin, via the Arnhem Highway.

The proposed activities will utilize and augment existing infrastructure. There will be construction of a new process plant, workers accommodation, administration buildings, Tailing's Storage Facility, waste dumps and other mining infrastructure.

The proposal is being assessed at the level of Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) by the Northern Territory Environmental Protection Authority (NT EPA) and Primary Gold has submitted a draft EIS for assessment.
